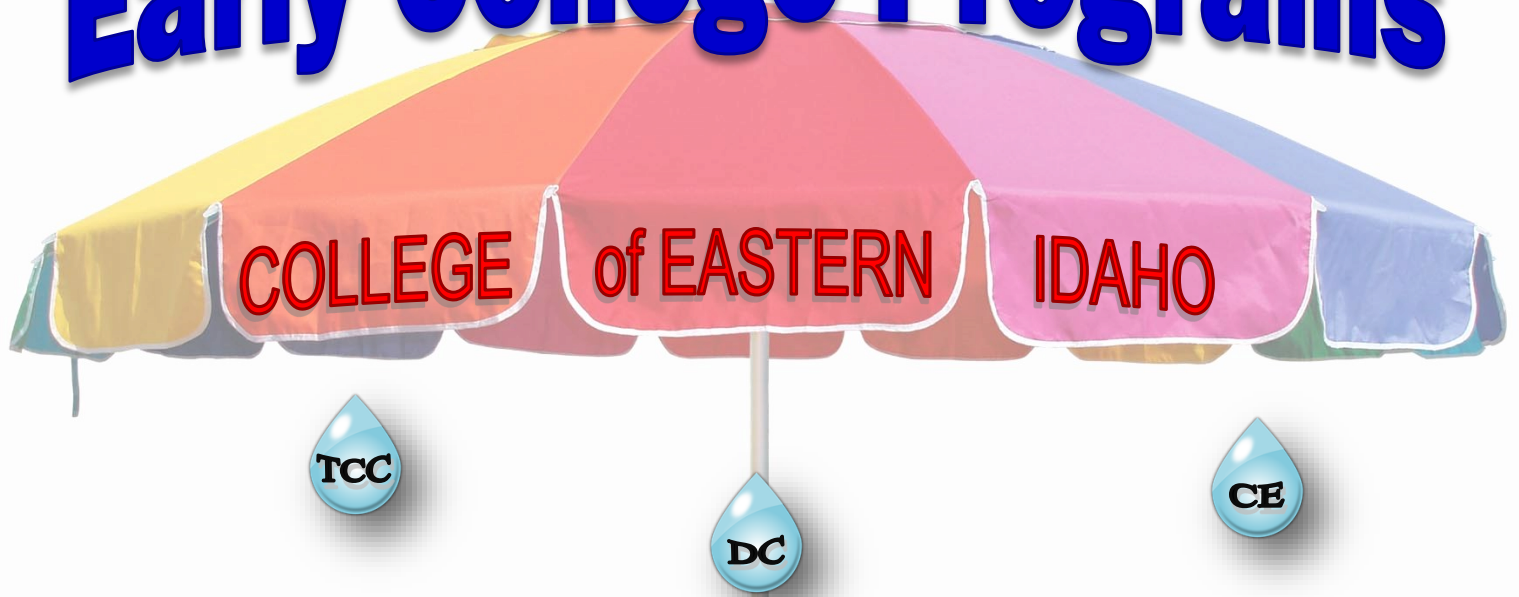

<b>Who ?</b>	Any High School/District offering the CTE course & students affiliated w/ these schools	Any high school student who is a least 16yrs old, has at least a 3.0 GPA, is in good standing with and has permission from the high school of attendance as well as permission from parents or guardians	Any high school student who is a least 16yrs old, has at least a 3.0 GPA, is in good standing with and has permission from the high school of attendance as well as permission from parents or guardians
<b>When ?</b>	During 9th—12th grade	During 10th—12th grade	During 10th—12th grade
<b>Why ?</b>	The High School student intends to go on to a Career & Technical college program or job after high school	Student wishes to take non-CTE courses that lead to a certificate or degree program at a post-secondary institution, while still in high school or wants to add to a CTE pathway	Student wishes to take courses that lead to a certificate or degree program <u>at</u> a post-secondary institution, while still in high school—when one is not offered on their respective high school campus
<b>How Much ?</b>	\$10 per credit, must be purchased by May 31st—2yrs from the completion of the TCC exam at the college, must also be enrolled at one of the 6 Idaho CTE schools offering the credits at the time of purchase	\$65 per credit, Fast Forward Funds eligible, SDE—pays CEI directly for their credit fees, student applies for funds during open window	\$65 per credit, Fast Forward Funds eligible, SDE—pays CEI directly for their tuition, the student is responsible for other course related fees
